is a seven-days Contact Making seminar organized by [ConseJoven](#) in **Toledo, Spain**, from **13th-19th May 2019** (travel days included).

With the participation of **associations from 7 different countries** along with experts in European projects, we aim to create a network of international cooperation and to develop the competences for implementing projects inside the European program Erasmus+: Youth and European Solidarity Corps.





Learning opportunities

The participants will acquire a **better knowledge and understanding of the Erasmus+** program, the projects' eligible criteria and evaluation method. Include **recent updates** regarding the European Solidarity Corps.

The partners will have the chance to **promote their own organization** as well as to **get to know others across Europe**.

A special attention will be put on sharing **good and bad practices**. Participants will have a space to share and learn from others' first-hand experiences.





The project aims to:

- Provide a **deeper and updated knowledge** about the **Erasmus+**: Youth program, its objectives, priorities, eligible criteria and project evaluation methodology, as well as the new Solidarity Corps.
- Present the participants with the opportunity to **get to know associations** from around Europe and the eligible countries.
- Create a **long-lasting and qualitative network** of international cooperation inside the Erasmus+ program.
- Offer a space to dialogue and work, so as to generate **ideas for new Erasmus+** projects in all its actions: KA1, KA2 and KA3.
- Start **elaborating those projects**.
- Share **good and bad practices**.
- Share **information and opportunities** offered by the Erasmus+ and ESC programs in the different countries.





Participants must be:

- over 18 years old.
- competent in using English as the working language.
- interested in establishing an international network of organizations.
- part of one of the partner organizations.
- committed to take an **active part in the whole duration of the project**, including a Skype preparation meeting, prepare for the activities, the CMS in Toledo and a follow-up activity.
- open to share and/or learn good and bad practices.
- ready to run an energizer (one per country).
- able to share what they learn in their community.





Group size:

20 participants belonging to associations from 7 countries: Bulgaria, FYROM, Italy, Latvia, Romania, Spain and Turkey.

Working language:

The working language will be **English**, with translations to/from **Spanish** if/when needed.



Accommodation:

Most of the activities and meals will take place in “Castillo de San Servando” Youth Hostel.

Accommodation will be in double rooms.

Financial conditions:

Travel expenses, food and accommodation will be covered by the Erasmus+ program according to its rules.
